A B O U T LAKE CONSTANCE



Catherine loves Lake Constance!

And when you come and experience this region, you will know why. Lake Constance (a.k.a. Bodensee) is one of the most beautiful areas in central Europe. The lake, being the third largest of central Europe, covers an area of 536 square kilometers (about 207 square miles) and connects the countries of Germany, Austria, and Switzerland.



Lake Constance is also an important drinking water source for some 4.5 million people in Germany and Switzerland. The lake's waters are primarily fed by the Alpine Rhine from Switzerland. The sheer size of this body of water and its great depth (250 meters) produce a microclimate all its own and milder temperatures. This often allows for Mediterranean trees and plants to thrive and has turned the whole region into a productive fruit and wine-growing landscape. Nevertheless, the area can also experience powerful storms and winds that race across the water.

The lake is popular for sailing, surfing, swimming, and cycling along its shores. An annual sailing regatta around the lake called the *Rund Um* ("all around") takes place every summer, and a magnificent ship procession with prayer and water consecration occurs each year on the day of the Assumption of Mary on August 15.

Many aviation, weaponry, and space technology companies are still linked to Friedrichshafen, such as Dornier (former Zeppelin Werke and today part of Airbus Defence and Space), ZF Friedrichshafen (the world's second largest car parts manufacturer), and MTU and Rolls-Royce Power Systems (producing high-speed engines and propulsion systems for ships and land, rail, and defense vehicles). Altogether, there are about 20 arms manufacturers and security engineering companies along Lake Constance.



Lindau is a town and historic island on the eastern end of Lake Constance, with historical documentation dating back as early as 882. Some of its buildings, such as Saint Peter's Church, go back 1000 years. It is a popular tourist destination due to its historic buildings, the harbor, and a beautiful panorama of the lake.

Every year since 1951, Lindau has hosted the Lindau Nobel Laureate Meetings which bring over 30 Nobel science laureates to the town—representing the largest convention of Nobel laureates in the world. These annual meetings host a full series of lectures, master classes, and panel discussions that alternate between a focus on the three natural sciences of physiology and medicine, physics, and chemistry. During this time, hundreds of young scientists, PhD students, and postgraduates from over 80 countries flood the town to engage in lively scientific discussions.

Each year, the science laureates visit the Island of Mainau on the last day of the meetings just as our group of Solari subscribers will do during the Hang.





Bregenz is the capital of the western Austrian province of Vorarlberg, situated along the Austrian shores of Lake Constance. Early settlements date back to 1500 BC. Perhaps due to its vicinity to Switzerland and Germany—and the opening to the world that the enormous lake provides— Bregenz has developed an unusual wealth of artistic and cultural events that draw thousands of visitors each year.



The Bregenz Festival, which features the world's largest floating stage—is an open-air amphitheater with 7000 seats that are fully booked each night during the Festival. The first edition of the festival was held in 1946—immediately attracting an international audience.

Because the town lacked a theater, the week's events were staged on barges moored on Lake Constance, launching the festival's signature commitment to floating stage opera productions.

This unique and "epic" staging of opera draws tens of thousands of spectators annually. Over 200,000 people attended the Festival's record-setting lake stage production of Mozart's *The Magic Flute* in 2014, which played to 100% capacity. The lake stage also features one of the world's best open-air sound systems.

THE VIENNA SYMPHONY ORCHESTRA

VIENNA'S "CULTURAL AMBASSADOR AND PREMIER CONCERT ORCHESTRA"

During our Hang 2020, all participants will enjoy both an indoor symphony performance of works of Ludwig van Beethoven and Richard Strauss by the Vienna Symphony Orchestra as well as a performance of the Giuseppe Verdi opera Rigoletto on the lake stage of the Bregenz Festival.

The Vienna Symphony Orchestra has been the Festival's orchestra since the beginning, playing a major role in the Festival's enduring success. It is considered Vienna's "cultural ambassador and premier concert orchestra" and one of Europe's most prestigious orchestral ensembles. Founded in 1900, the orchestra is known for its commitment to traditional, Viennese orchestral sound, which it shows off in a core repertoire focused on works from the Romantic era. The orchestra has been in residence at the Bregenz Festival since the Festival's inception; it is not only responsible for the Festival's indoor and outdoor opera productions but also regularly headlines orchestral concerts on the Festival program.

RIGOLETTO

Rigoletto is an opera in three acts by Giuseppe Verdi. The Italian libretto was written by Francesco Maria Piave based on the play Le roi s'amuse by Victor Hugo. Despite serious initial problems with the Austrian censors who had control over northern Italian theaters at the time, the opera had a triumphant premiere at La Fenice in Venice on 11 March 1851.

Rigoletto is a staple of the operatic repertoire. It had its first performance in 1851, based on Victor Hugo's play *The King Amuses Himself*. Following extended negotiations with censors, Verdi and his librettist changed the plot's womanizer to a duke and named the duke's jester Rigoletto.

It is widely considered to be the first of the operatic masterpieces of Verdi's middle-tolate career. Its tragic story revolves around the licentious Duke of Mantua, his hunchbacked court jester Rigoletto, and Rigoletto's beautiful daughter Gilda. The opera's original title, *La maledizione (The Curse)*, refers to a curse placed on both the Duke and Rigoletto by a courtier whose daughter the Duke has seduced with Rigoletto's encouragement. The curse comes to fruition when Gilda falls in love with the Duke and sacrifices her life to save him from the assassin hired by her father. GIUSEPPE FORTUNINO FRANCESCO

VERDI

1813 - 1901

Giuseppe Fortunino Francesco

Verdi was an Italian opera composer. He was born near Busseto to a provincial family of moderate means, and developed a musical education with the help of a local patron. Verdi came to dominate the Italian opera scene after the era of Vincenzo Bellini, Gaetano Donizetti, and Gioachino Rossini, whose works significantly influenced him.

In his early operas, Verdi demonstrat-

ed a sympathy with the Risorgimento movement, which sought the unification of Italy. He also participated briefly as an elected politician. The chorus "Va, pensiero" from his early opera *Nabucco* (1842), and similar choruses in later operas, were much in the spirit of the unification movement, and the composer himself became esteemed as a representative of these ideals. An intensely private person, Verdi, however, did not seek to ingratiate himself with popular movements. As he became professionally successful, he was able to reduce his operatic workload and sought to establish himself as a landowner in his native region. He surprised the musical world by returning, after his success with the opera *Aida* (1871), with three late masterpieces: his *Requiem* (1874), and the operas *Otello* (1887) and *Falstaff* (1893).





We begin each morning session with a prayer & meditation, and end with a discussion.

FLY INTO ZRH, MUC, OR FDH Those arriving by plane should fly into either the Zurich (ZRH) or Munich (MUC) airports and take the train from there to Lindau (Bodensee), Germany. Do not make the mistake of going to Lindau, Switzerland, which is in the Zurich canton! There is also a small local airport at Friedrichshafen (FDH) only 30 minutes from Lindau that has connecting flights to Frankfurt (FRA).



From the Zurich airport, take a train (2.5 hours) Swiss Rail services: https://www.sbb.ch/en/

From the Munich airport, take a train (3.5 hours) German Rail services: https://www.bahn.com/en/ Once in Lindau, the train station is about two miles from the Hotel Bad Schachen where the Solari Hang will be based.
